Fair is Fair

Anticipatory Set

1. **ASK** students to imagine a very large chocolate chip cookie. Then, ask them to imagine that only one student will get the cookie; that student will get to eat the whole cookie by themselves while everyone else gets none.
2. **ASK** them if this is fair. How would they feel if this actually happened?
3. **ASK** students what they think the word “fair” means. Give examples of situations being fair.

Learning Goal

I will know what fair is.

Steps

1. **READ** the book *Fair is Fair* by Sonny Varela.
2. **DISCUSS** what the animals thought was fair and what they really learned was fair.
3. **DISCUSS** that fair may not mean the same. Fair may mean everyone getting what they need.
4. **DISCUSS** ways we need to be fair in the classroom/school.

Checks for Understanding

1. **INSTRUCT** students to draw a picture of themselves being/playing fair in the classroom or at school.
